Remco Dijkman is assistant professor in Information Systems at Eindhoven University of Technology. His research interests include Business Process Management and Service Oriented Computing. He received his Ph.D. from the University of Twente, where he has held positions as a postdoctoral researcher and as a research assistant. Before working at the University of Twente, he combined work as a research assistant at the Open University of the Netherlands with work as a consultant at Ordina. He has been a visitor of the BPT group at the Hasso Plattner Institute, IBM Zurich Research Lab, the Institute of Information Systems at Humboldt-University Berlin, and the BPM group at Queensland University of Technology. Remco has published over 50 papers in scientific journals, conferences and workshops. His work appeared in Information Systems, Computers in Industry and Transactions on Software Engineering and Methodology. He has worked as a researcher in a number of national and international projects, including the SPICE European project; and the SHOPPS, NLI, ArCo, and A-MUSE national projects; and he is co-founder of the Dutch BPM Round Table and the European BPM Round Table, both platforms that stimulate collaboration between researchers and practitioners. Currently, Remco is project leader of the GET Service European project.
