A submission as scientific paper (**full paper**) must be accompanied by a digital presentation if accepted for the conference. Below are the respective guidelines:

- **Scientific Paper (Full Paper)**

The Scientific Paper (between 4.000 – 6.000 words) must include:

- Title of paper
- Name(s) of authors incl. full postal address, telephone, fax and e-mail address
- Abstract (max 300 words)
- Keywords (max 10 words)
- Introduction
- Conclusion and Outlook
- Bibliography

The decision regarding acceptance will be made by the end of August 2015. Authors must intend to register for and attend the conference to present the paper if it is accepted

- **Digital Presentation**

The presentation should consist of maximum 15 slides (excluding cover sheet, content and back cover sheet). The presentation time is maximum 20 minutes. - The official language of the conference is **English**
- **All full paper submission will be double-blind reviewed**
